## COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic Registration Opens on Thursday, April 1 at 8:30am Free Vaccination Clinic at Sunnyview Expo Center Open to All Individuals 18 and Older

**OSHKOSH, Wis., March 31, 2021** –The Winnebago County COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic will open registration Thursday, April 1 at 8:30 am for clinics being held on Tuesday, April 6 and Thursday, April 8 at Sunnyview Expo Center (500 E County Road Y, Oshkosh, WI). - Tuesday, April 6, 8am-3:45pm – Johnson & Johnson/Janssen Vaccine Clinic, 1-dose
- Thursday, April 8, 8am-4:45pm – Moderna Vaccine Clinic, second dose clinic on May 6

**Appointments are required.** Registration will open to all individuals 18 years and older.

Tuesday, April 6<sup>th</sup> will be a one-dose, Johnson & Johnson/Janssen vaccination clinic. You will not need to return for a second dose and will be considered fully vaccinated 14 days following your vaccination.

Thursday, April 8<sup>th</sup> will be a 2-dose series, Moderna vaccination clinic. Second dose appointments will be scheduled on May 6<sup>th</sup>. You will be considered fully vaccinated 14 days following your second dose.
