FREE COVID-19 VACCINATION CLINIC AT ST. ANDREW'S CHURCH IN OSHKOSH Vaccination Available to Anyone 12 Years and Older, Thursday, July 1

You will be considered fully vaccinated 14 days following your vaccination.

Public health nurses will be on-hand to answer any questions community members may have. Liaisons from the Oshkosh Area School District will be available to assist with translation as needed.
