## FREE COVID-19 VACCINE CLINIC IN WINNECONNE ON MONDAY, DECEMBER 20

Vaccination available to anyone 5 years and older

**OSHKOSH, Wis. (December 17, 2021)** – The Winnebago County Health Department will offer two free COVID-19 vaccination clinics in Winneconne at the Winneconne-Poygan Fire Department (550 W Main St., Winneconne, Wis.). The first clinic will be Monday, December 20, from 3:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. An additional clinic will be held on Tuesday, January 11, from 3:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m., also at the Winneconne-Poygan Fire Department.

The clinics are open to anyone 5 years and older, and appointments are not required. First, second, and third Pfizer vaccine doses, along with booster doses of the Pfizer vaccine will be available. Anyone under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian present. Public health staff will be on-hand to answer any questions community members may have.

Free assistance is available to individuals in Winnebago, Outagamie and Calumet counties who need transportation or help navigating transportation options to their COVID-19 vaccination appointments.
