VICTIM IMPACT STATEMENT

The purpose of a Victim Impact Statement is to tell the court two key things:

- 1. How you have been affected by the defendant's criminal behavior (physically, emotionally, financially, etc.) and;
 - 2. What you would recommend for the accused at sentencing.

A Victim Impact Statement is different from the statement of facts, which you may have given to police during their investigation, because rather than describing what happened, you are communicating *how the crime impacted you and what you believe is an appropriate sentence*. If the victim is a minor (under 18): please feel free to draw a picture and as a parent of a minor, you may also submit a statement.
