# Violence and Winnebago County High School Students

## What is the problem?

- 27.8% of students reported being in a physical fight during the past 12 months before the survey.
- 9.2% of students reported being in a physical fight on school property during the past 12 months before the survey.
- 16.7% of students reported that someone tried to hurt them by hitting, punching, or kicking them while on school property during the past 12 months before the survey.
- **30.3%** of students reported that they have been bullied **on school property**.
- 11.0% of students reported rarely or never feeling safe from physical harm while at school.
- 27.3% of students agrees or strongly agrees that violence is a problem at their school.
- **7.9%** of students reported that their boyfriend or girlfriend hit, slapped, or physically hurt them on purpose during the past 12 months before the survey.
- **11.1%** of students reported that have been forced, either verbally or physically, to take part in a sexual activity.
- 20.1% of students reported that they purposely hurt themselves without wanting to die, such as cutting or burning themselves during the 12 months before the survey.
