	Shoreline/Streambank Erosion Eligibility Criteria
	Any landowner with a site experiencing soil loss greater than 1 ton of soil per year with adjacent wetlan aquatic vegetation may apply for financial assistance.
	Any landowner with a site experiencing soil loss greater than 3 tons of soil per year may apply for finar assistance.
	Shoreline Habitat Restoration for Developed Areas (SHRUB) Eligibility Criteria
	Any landowner with a site that: exhibits poor soil stability adjacent to their shoreline; has the potential to deliver nutrients/pollutants to waterbody/ies; has depleted native vegetation along their shoreline.
	Animal Lot/Manure Runoff Eligibility Criteria
	Any landowner with a site contributing 50 pounds or more of phosphorus to surface water per year may apply for financial assistance for all barnyard runoff control practices necessary to reduce the phosphor loading below 15 pounds per year.
	Any landowner with a site that contributes 15 - 49 pounds of phosphorus per year to surface water may apply for financial assistance for clean water practices.
	Any landowner required by County Ordinance and/or State Law to do nutrient management planning (I may apply for financial assistance.
	Any landowner voluntarily doing NMP may apply for financial assistance.
	Soil Erosion Eligibility Criteria
	Any landowner with a cropped field within 1,000 ft of surface water and a soil loss of 1/2 T or higher ba on the current soil loss prediction model may apply for financial assistance for high residue manageme
	Any landowner with a field experiencing gully erosion, as determined by LWCD staff, may apply for fina assistance for a grassed waterway or other needed BMPs.
	Groundwater Contamination Eligibility Criteria
	Any landowner with a dug or drilled well removed from service, posing a threat to groundwater quality a public safety as determined by LWCD staff, may apply for financial assistance.
-	Any landowner with a naturally occurring sink hole and/or direct conduit to groundwater, posing a threa groundwater quality and/or public safety as determined by LWCD staff, may apply for financial assistant
